COLLEGE RULES & REGULATIONS

WORKING DAYS: The College works on all days except Sundays and holidays declared by the institution. If necessary, classes may be held on some of these days also.

SCHEDULE AND ASSEMBLY: The working hours of the College is from 9.00 a.m. to 2.45 p.m. and for the office from 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. The above timings are liable to be changed by the Management and the Management's decision will be final in the matter. College starts with prayer at 8.50 a.m. All the Staff and Students should attend the Prayer. Recitation from Holy Quran is followed by "Sare Jahan Se Acha" the National Song, written by Dr. Allama Iqbal and a verse from Thirukkural during the assembly. A message on ethical values and current news is shared every day.

PAYMENT OF FEE: At the time of admission, the fees for the first term of the course concerned shall be paid. No student will be enrolled or permitted to attend classes until the fee due for her are paid for I and II term. The fees are payable on or before and not later than the dates specified in the handbook. The principal may fix different dates for different classes for the payment of college fee and it should be paid within the stipulated time.

Students shall make note of this and make payment in time. If a student fails to pay the fee on the date prescribed, she will have to pay a fine of Rs.10/- for each working day and if she fails to pay the fee even within the extended date, her name will be struck off from the rolls. If re- admitted, she has to pay the fee and fine due by her.

STUDENTS' DRESS CODE: Students should wear only Salwar Kameez and Dupatta of any colour. Modest and Formal dress code should be followed by the students – Wearing leggings, sleeveless, firm-fitting and extravagant clothes should be strictly avoided in the premises. No immodest attire/ heavy makeup shall be encouraged.

VISITORS: No male parent should enter the college premises at any time. If it is necessary, the visitors should give the intent to visit the

College. Then the Principal will meet the male parents in his/her chamber. Visitors are requested to wait before they are called by the Principal. They should send in their card mentioning the purpose of their visit.

IDENTITY CARD: Every student of the college is expected to possess an Identity Card with her photograph affixed on it, duly attested by the Principal. The students are advised to keep the card with them always and use it on the following occasions:

- To get concession tickets to travel by bus or rail.
- To become a member of the USIS Library, The British Council Library, Connemara Library or other Public Libraries.
- For postal Identity.
- As an Identification Certificate when appearing for Examinations.
- For the receipt of concession, scholarships, etc, in the College.

The students should carry the Identity card with them always and produce the card whenever demanded by the Principal or any member of the staff. Students may obtain their Identity Cards from their respective Heads of the Departments.

ADMISSION

UG Degree: Candidates for admission to the Three Years Degree courses must have passed 12th Standard Examination or any examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the Thiruvalluvar University.

PG Degree: Candidates for admission to the Two year Post Graduate Degree courses must have passed the qualifying degree examination of any recognized University as equivalent thereto by the Thiruvalluvar University.

Note: Students who are found to have obtained admission by forged documents or false representation in regard to their eligibility or otherwise, will be summarily dismissed with forfeiture of all fees paid and reported to the University and to the concerned authorities for necessary action.

WITHDRAWAL AFTER ADMISSION

A student who has been assigned a seat or has paid the tuition and special fee or who, after the commencement of a term, leaves the College after admission at any time irrespective of whether she had attended the class or not, cannot claim refund of whole or any part of the fee paid by her.

Students leaving the college at the beginning or at the end of any term in the middle of the course, for any reason whatsoever, will have to pay the fee payable forth at term in which she was last marked attendance in the College.

No refund of any fee already paid will be admissible. Students are advised to retain their fee receipt with them till the completion of the course, and should be produced, if required.

The college authorities reserve the right to increase the tuition and other fee if they consider it necessary to do so.

All students and their parents or guardians will be deemed to have agreed to this rule as a condition for the admission of the student into the college.

TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

- Students applying for Transfer Certificate within 3 months from the date of declaration of the Final Examination results may avail it without any Fee.
- Students applying for TC after the aforementioned period up to a period of one year shall have to pay a processing fee of Rs.200/- .
- Thereafter, Rs.100/- shall be additionally charged for every single year along with the processing fee.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE RULES

- Students must be present on the re-opening day of the College.
- Regular attendance in classes, prayer Assembly, all the college functions and Meetings is compulsory. Absence from these will be considered as an act of indiscipline. Attendance on the

Independence Day and the Republic Day Celebration is compulsory for all the students and staff of the College.

- Attendance shall be taken at every lecture, practical or tutorial class prescribed in the college timetable.
- Each department shall maintain a daily record of the attendance of each student and the lecturer shall report promptly to the Head of the Department about the absentees.
- Persistent absence for a week from classes, prayer assemblies, laboratories or other exercise (including physical education) without justifiable cause, will be sufficient reason for the student's name to be struck off from the rolls.
- No student shall absent herself without leave letter for any day or part of the day. Application for leave must be made to the Principal through the Counsellor/ Class In-charge, who will forward the same to the Principal.
- When absent due to unforeseen cause, an application for leave must be submitted as early as possible and in no case later than on the first day of return to college.
- Leave will not be granted during working hours for the purpose of meeting parents or guardians. The students shall keep their parents or guardians informed that they should not be disturbed during working hours in the college and they should conform to the rules of the college.
- Absence without leave for the whole or part of the day renders the student liable to be fined or lose their attendance.
- A student absent without leave for any hour of the day will be regarded as being absent for half a day.
- In case of sickness, the Principal may require the production of a medical certificate from the College Medical Officer or from a Registered Medical Practitioner.
- Students, who absent themselves from classes on specified day after a vacation, shall be fined.
- The annual certificate of attendance required for the University Examination will in no case be granted unless,

- i. The principal is satisfied that the student's progress and conduct has been satisfactory.
- ii. The student has paid all the fees and dues to the college and returned all the books borrowed by her to the library.
- iii. Student should have attended three-fourths of the number of working days i.e., 75%.
- iv. A candidate who has secured less than 75% but 65% and above attendance in any semester separately for theory and practicals shall be permitted to take the examination on the recommendations of the Head of the Institution to condone the lack of attendance on the payment of prescribed fees to the University separately for theory and practicals.
- v. A candidate who has secured less than 65% but 55% and above attendance in any semester in theory as well as in practical has to compensate the shortage of attendance in the subsequent semester besides earning the required percentage of attendance in that semester and appear for both semester papers together at the end of the later semester on the payment of the prescribed fees to the university separately for theory and practical.
- vi. A candidate, who has secured less than 55% of attendance in any semester separately for theory and practicals, shall not be permitted to appear for the regular examinations in that particular semester or in subsequent semesters. She has to rejoin/re-do the semester in which the attendance is less than 55%, on the payment of prescribed fees to the University, separately for theory and practicals, after getting prior approval of the University.

The College Management has the right to direct the Principal not to forward to the University the names of candidates, for purpose of examination, who have failed to pay the college fee or any fine or those whose conduct has been found to be unsatisfactory.

EXAMINATIONS AND TESTS

Examinations for all classes are held periodically. Further, Tests in all subjects are held from time to time. Attendance in these Tests and Examinations is compulsory. Absence from Tests and Examinations without valid reason will not be accepted and will be dealt with strictly.

Progress cards containing the marks secured in the Tests and Examinations are sent to the parents or guardians.

PROMOTION AND SELECTION

All the students are required to take Tests and Examinations. No student admitted to college is automatically eligible for promotion and selection. Besides student's attendance, her progress in studies and conduct as assessed by the staff and the Principal will be the only consideration for promotion to the next class or selection for the university examinations. The Principal may, at his/her discretion, expel a student from the college who does not show adequate progress in studies or who is irregular in attendance or whose conduct is not satisfactory.

RAGGING

As per the University Grants Commission's letter No. F.8-1/99 (PP-II) dated 13.01.2000, ragging may include: Display of noisy, disorderly conduct, teasing incitement by rough or rude treatment or handling, indulging in rowdiness, undisciplined activities which cause or likely to cause annoyance, undue hardship, physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear in a fresher or asking the students to do any act or perform something which a student will not do in the ordinary course and which causes her shame or embarrassment or danger to her life.

G.O. on Ragging: The Government of Tamil Nadu has prohibited ragging within or outside any educational institutions by passing a Government Order "Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act 1997" vide their Order No. 7 of 1997 dt. 14.02.1997 which says that whoever

directly or indirectly participates or propagates “ragging” will be punished as follows:

- i) Imprisonment upto a term of two years
- ii) A fine of ₹ 10,000/-
- iii) Students convicted of the offence will be dismissed from the institution and will not be admitted in any other institution.

As per G.O., any student found guilty of ragging and or abetting ragging shall be expelled from the institution.

LABORATORY

Great care must be taken in handling apparatus. All breakages, damages, losses, etc., must be reported to the lecturer-in-charge of practical concerned as soon as they occur. The cost of the breakages, damages will be collected from the students concerned individually or collectively. These should be brought to the notice of the Principal forthwith. It is the duty of the lecturer to conform to the rule strictly. The work tables and sanitary fittings should be kept absolutely clean and tidy at all times. This should be seen by the Heads of the Department and the lecturers- in-charge. The Science laboratories are provided with very costly and sophisticated equipments. Extra care and caution is therefore needed in this case from the student, the staff and the attendants.

THE COLLEGE LIBRARY

GENERAL RULES

The library works on all the days except on Government Holidays. The library is open to all students and members of the staff of the College from 8.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. and access permitted to all the books and systems of the virtual library except for the special reference section that requires special permission from the teacher.

While entering and leaving the library, a student should press the biometric device to clock her stay in the library.

No books, notebooks, files, bags are allowed to be taken into the library. Such materials may be left at the counter outside the library. Library is not responsible for any loss of property at the counter. Only sheets of paper may be taken into the library.

All members must show their Identity Card to the library staff when requested. No one may bring non-members into the library.

Perfect silence should be observed in the library and also in the corridors and lobbies of the college during working hours. Breach in this rule will entail serious notice followed by fine. Students should avail the library without wasting their precious time during the hours when they have no classes.

The value of the books lost or damaged will be recovered from the students and the staff responsible for the said damage. Penalty for loss/damage of books will be paid at the main office following which books will be further issued on producing the payment receipt.

Every student of the college may be allowed to take two books at a time, from the library. Each student will be given two library cards. A book will be lent to her only in exchange of the card. The cards will be handed back to the students when she returns the books. All books on loan shall be returned not later than one week from the date of issue. If, however, the books are returned after expiry of due date, the card will be handed back to her only after the overdue charges are paid. The overdue charge for the late return will be ₹5/- per volume per day. A student who does not return the book beyond the due period, on more than five occasions will forfeit the privilege of borrowing the books for overnight use.

All cards shall be returned to the library before the commencement of End Semester Examinations or when the student leaves the college after course completion or discontinues. A fee of ₹25/- will be charged for each card lost and for the issue of a duplicate. Student will also be held responsible for any book borrowed on the card lost by her.

Students are not permitted to sub-lend to anyone the reader's card or the books of the library. A student against whom any over dues or other charges are outstanding shall not be allowed to get back her cards or borrow books until she has paid the due amount. A student

who has lost her card shall make a prompt written report of the same to the librarian and shall pay the price for the same.

Books must not be marked or defaced or torn in any manner.

Students should examine each book before borrowing and immediately report the damage, if any, to the librarian, if they fail to do so, they will be held responsible for any damage detected after use of the books by them.

No Transfer / Conduct / Attendance Certificate shall be issued to a student until the books and cards have been returned and any dues outstanding against the student are discharged.

Staff and students shall ensure books be returned to the library one week before the end of each term. If the student is to appear for University Examination, she has to return the book one week before the Attendance Certificate is sent to the university. Failure to comply with this rule entails penalty and non-issue of all cards.

Reference books are only for consultation and they shall not be issued under any circumstances.

Absence from the college shall not be an excuse for delay in returning the books.

The Librarian may recall a book at any time, even before the due date.

Any book in great demand may be lent for a shorter period.

The Librarian, the attendants and the readers shall be responsible individually or collectively for any loss or damage done to the books, equipment or other property belonging to the library either intentionally or otherwise. The Management's decision in the matter will be final.

While accessing e-resources of the library, proper entries are to be made in the records of the library. Downloading of the information is also permitted as per norms.

Accessing non-educational context / information from the internet is strictly prohibited.

Current journals / back volumes and locker books are not issued for home reading. They are to be referred inside the library only.

All books should be replaced in the respective shelves before the closure of the college for any of the terms.

Students and staff can make use of the photocopying facilities available in the library.

COLLEGE UNION - STUDENTS' MAJLIS

The office bearers of the College Union are the President, the Vice President and the Secretaries of the various departments and committees. They are the outstanding students among the respective departments selected by the Principal and Heads of the various departments. The class representatives are nominated by the Principal at the beginning of each year. One staff member will be appointed as mentor to the College Union and every association will function under the guidance of a member of the staff.

BUS FACILITY

Bus facility is provided for students coming from Pernambut, Omerabad, Ambur and Tirupattur. Bus pass shall be provided to the students on payment of transport fee. Only those students who possess the bus pass and identity card will be allowed to travel by college bus.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

Students are expected to conduct themselves in such a manner as not to bring discredit to the college or staff or to themselves. The reputation of the college depends upon the students, whether on or off the college campus.

It is expected that students will be courteous and gracious to the members of the staff, members of the Governing Body, distinguished visitors and invitees to the college. They should greet them when they meet them, even if they do not know them. They should rise when the teacher and visitors enter a class or reading room or when they approach to speak to them.

- Students should get prior permission from the Principal to take part in intercollegiate competitions or to appear on radio, TV, or any other media, including publishing articles in newspapers, magazines or journals, or organizing any meeting inside the campus or collecting money for any purpose or for print or distribution of any material whatsoever.
- Students are allotted a mentor and should make use of the mentor's guidance
- Change of residential address, contact number and email ID, if any, should be reported to their mentors.
- Students shall cooperate with the authorities in keeping the premises clean and tidy. While handling the property of the college, any damage caused casually or deliberately shall entail disciplinary action towards recovery of cost and fine.
- Ragging is completely prohibited in the college. Any student indulging in any form of ragging inside or outside the college campus will be severely dealt with as per the order of the Govt. of Tamil Nadu and regulations of UGC.
- The use of mobile phones is restricted in the college and shall be exclusively permitted only for digital learning, attending online tests as and when intimated by the mentors or for verification purposes to access student's scholarship schemes all dependent on the necessity of its use. The offenders will be fined and their mobiles will not be returned.
- During the working hours or during extra/ remedial classes after working hours, the students shall not leave the campus without permission from the Class In-charge, HOD and the Principal.
- Late coming / Tardiness is to be strictly avoided as late comers will be adequately fined. Penalty will be levied on late comers.
- Smoking as well as consuming intoxicants are strictly prohibited within the premises of the campus and while representing the institution.
- Refusal to identify one's self to any college authority is punishable. The preferred form of identification shall be current, valid institute identification card.

- Students are not allowed to celebrate Birthdays or any form of parties within the college premises.
- Altering, improperly possessing or lending the institution identification card to another person for any reason is not permitted.
- Students should take care of their belongings while within the campus. The institution will not be responsible for loss of any personal belongings.
- All requisition letters for bonafide certificates, scholarship forms and charitable trust scholarships forms should be addressed to the Principal through HOD.
- Parents should feel free to spend their time to discuss their wards' performance with their Mentor / HOD / Principal.
- Canteen should be used for buying / eating food only. It should not be used for academic or recreational activities. Lingering in the canteen after the break-time shall entail consequences.
- Students are forbidden from entering the administrative office and the staff room during unspecified hours unless called for.
- Students interested in working after college hours in the Laboratories or for sports or any other curricular and extracurricular activities should take permission from their parents and head of their respective departments.
- Flex should be pasted only on the frames provided for the purpose. Before pasting of any flex, it should be approved by the concerned authority.
- Students can use suggestion box for constructive suggestions, improvements required in any system or queries of a unique nature.
- The students going out of the campus for academic purpose – Field Trips / Industrial Visits / Competitions/ Conferences etc. shall have to produce consent letter from their parents beforehand.
- All the students should have their own bank account with a GPay or PhonePe app linked to the account in their phones. The students should be prepared to pay their Exam fee to the university without delays or any kind of difficulties.

- Giving gifts personally to the teachers in any form is prohibited unless it is formally approved by the head of the institution.
- Online purchase on college address shall not be tolerated. Any goods thus bought shall be returned back.
