ANNUAL REPORT 2023-2024

Honorable members of the Management, Esteemed General Secretary, Secretary and Correspondent, respected Advisor, faculty members and students.

The College was established in 1997, rooted in the rich legacy of the Vaniyambadi Muslim Educational Society since 1903, this institution, among several others, have become a cornerstone of education in the region. Today, it stands as a welcoming haven, providing avenues for higher education and skill development, reflecting the community's commitment to nurturing growth.

At present, the college works with over 2169 students, 113 Teaching and 25 Non-Teaching Staff, and offers 16 UG Programs, 7 PG programs and 3 P.hD programs. Our primary concern is to provide quality education. And to this end, I am glad to state that of the 648 students who took the End Semester Examinations held in June 2023, 557 have successfully passed with the departments of Zoology, Interior Design and Décor, Biochemistry and Computer Applications securing 100% results.

I take great pleasure in presenting the Annual Report of Islamiah Women's Arts and Science College for the year 2023– 2024. College reopened for all classes except for I UG and I PG on 19.6.23. Classes commenced for the I UG on 3.7.23 and for I PG on 26.8.23.
