#### Report

Industrial Visit - Vanitec Ltd, Vaniyambadi

A group of 32 Students with faculties from Islamiah Women's Arts and Science College, Vaniyambadi II and III B.Sc. Chemistry classes and three faculty members from the department of chemistry went on an industrial visit to VANITEC LTD (Zero Liquid Discharge Common Effluent Treatment Plant ZLDCETP) in Valayampet on February 19, 2021. The visit's objectives were to broaden students' knowledge and comprehension of how industries run and to give them hands-on experience with industrial processes, procedures, and technology related to wastewater treatment principles. During the Primary Treatment, the wastewater was cleared of fine debris and suspended solids. A group of bacteria were then used in a biological treatment phase to break down the remaining dissolved organics, preparing the wastewater for river disposal.
