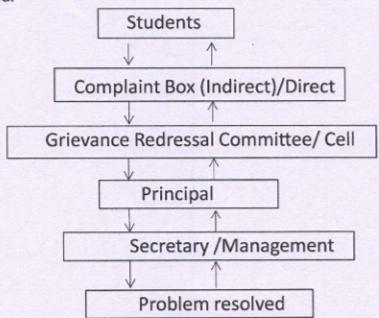

MECHANISM FOR GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL

Every month the students' grievance cell meets and their grievances are promptlyaddressed.



Mechanism for Student Grievance Submission (online/offline)

Email Submission:

- Students can submit grievances via email to a designated email address specifically created for this purpose. [Principal's email address: principaliwe@gmail.com]
- Clearly communicate the email address to students through official circular, website, and student handbook.

Complaints Box Submission:

 Install physical complaints boxes at strategic locations across campus, such as near administrative offices, libraries, and in all the blocks.

- Provide complaint forms alongside the box for students to fill out their grievances anonymously or with identification if they prefer.
- Regularly collect and review submissions from the complaints box to ensure timely response and resolution.

Direct Submission to Grievances Redressal Cell:

- Establish a dedicated Grievances Redressal Cell with appointed staff or committee members responsible for handling student grievances.
- Designate specific office hours or appointment slots for students to directly submit their grievances in person to the Grievances Redressal Cell.
- Ensure that the Grievances Redressal Cell maintains confidentiality and handles grievances with sensitivity and professionalism.

Submission to Principal:

- Allow students to submit grievances directly to the Principal's office through designated channels, such as via email, in-person appointments, or official complaint forms.
- Communicate clearly to students the procedure for submitting grievances to the Principal and provide contact details for the Principal's office.

Acknowledgment and Tracking:

- Upon receiving a grievance, whether through email, complaints box, or direct submission, promptly acknowledge receipt to the student.
- Maintain a centralized tracking system to monitor the status and progress of each grievance from submission to resolution.

Timely Response and Resolution:

- Ensure that all grievances are reviewed and addressed in a timely manner, adhering to predefined timelines for response and resolution.
- Communicate the outcome of the grievance investigation and any actions taken to the student through their preferred communication channel (email, in-person meeting, etc.).

Feedback and Continuous Improvement:

- Encourage students to provide feedback on the grievance handling process to identify areas for improvement.
- Regularly review and update the grievance submission and redressal mechanisms based on feedback and evolving needs.

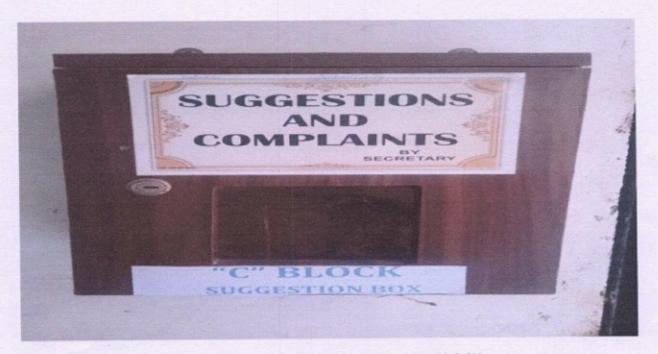

SUGGESTION/COMPLAINT BOX AT "D" BLOCK





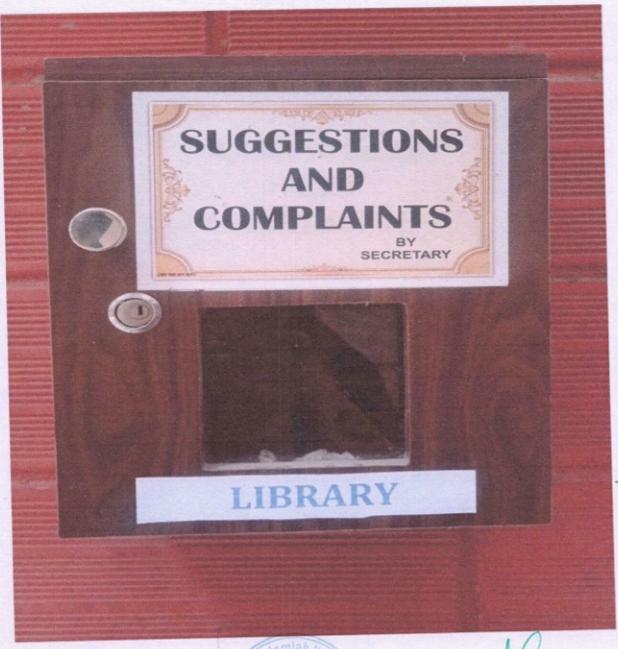
