ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2019-2020

It gives me great pleasure to present the Annual Report of the College for the year 2019-2020.

CONVOCATION:

The 20th Convocation Ceremony for the batch 2016-2019 was held on 29th February 2020 presided over by the Chief Guest Honorable. Dr. Anita Sumanth, Judge, Madras High Court, Chennai.

576 students were awarded degrees of which 19 had secured University Ranks.

UNIVERSITY INSPECTION COMMISSION

The University Inspection Commission visited the college in June 2019 to verify and grant fresh and Continuation affiliation for fresh and existing UG, PG and research programs. Dr. V. Balu, Member-Syndicate, Thiruvalluvar University, and Dr. A. Mohammed Sadiq, Member-Syndicate, Thiruvalluvar University, Principal, Adhiparasakthi College of Arts & Science, Kalavi, Vellore, was the Convenor of the Commission. The commission was fully satisfied and recommended the University for the grant of affiliation to the courses to Islamiah Women's Arts and Science College.

The University Inspection Commission visited the college for the second time on 03rd March 2020 to verify the infrastructural and instructional facilities available in the college for the grant of fresh affiliation for B.Sc. Zoology. Dr. M. Chitra, Member Syndicate and Associate Professor, Department of Mathematics, Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, served as the Convener for the Inspection Commission. The commission was fully satisfied and recommended the University for the grant of affiliation to the above course to the College.
