

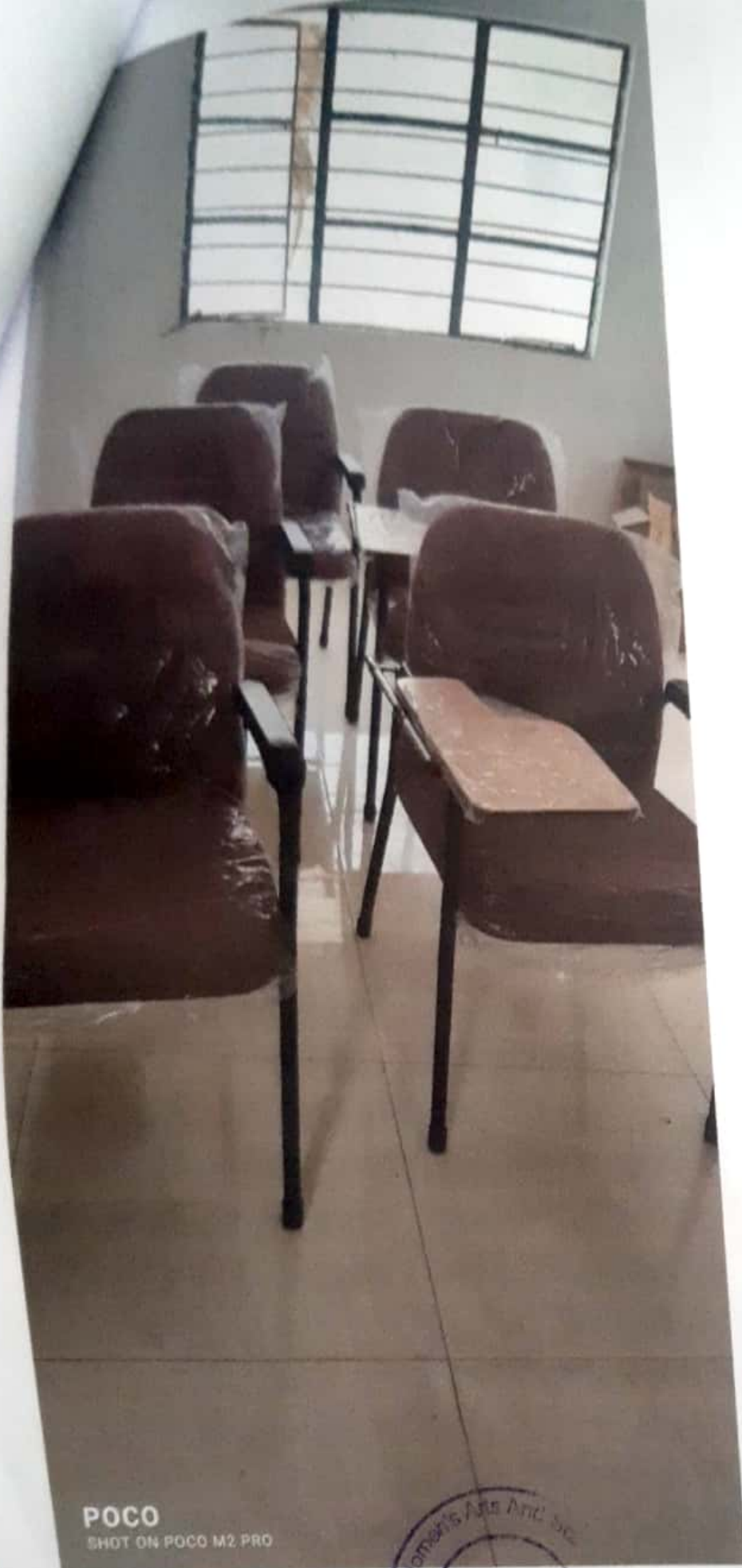

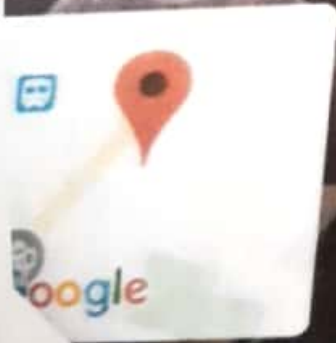

## E-DEFENSE FOR WOMEN

### REPORT

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Islamiah Women's Arts & Science College in organized Women's Day awareness program on E-DEFENSE FOR WOMEN on 08.03.2021 at 11.00 a.m in the seminar hall. Close to 600 students and staff members participated in this awareness program. The Program began with the recitation of verses from the Holy Quran with its English Tamil translations. Ms. JAYALAKSHMI B, Inspector of Police, All Women's Police Station, Vaniyambadi, was the resource person for the occasion.

Delivering the Presidential address, Dr. M. Renu, Principal, IWASC commented upon the numerous instances where women, despite being skilled and educated are reticent for the fear of facing uncomfortable situations. The key to overcoming such fear is not 'hiding' but strengthening oneself against all such eventualities.

The Inspector shared with the students her own journey from being a fearful girl to a strong woman police officer. It is okay to be afraid, she said. But it is not okay to allow that fear to rule one's life choices. It is all about how one deals with his/her fears that makes them a coward or a brave individual.

She spoke about the KAVALAN App devised by the Tamil Nadu Police that tracks every place a woman travels to and in case of dangerous situations a mere shake of the phone would send signal to the control room of the nearest Police station from where help would arrive within the shortest duration possible.

Besides depending on the gadgets and modern technology, Ms. Jayalakshmi encouraged students to develop their self-confidence so as to be capable of facing bullies, molesters, frauds who mislead innocent women etc., A woman who is aware of her surroundings, she felt, was a safe woman.

The enthusiasm of the students was palpable and Inspector's suggestions was met with conviction and grateful acceptance. The session came to an end with an oath to protect and progress, a vote of thanks and National Anthem.

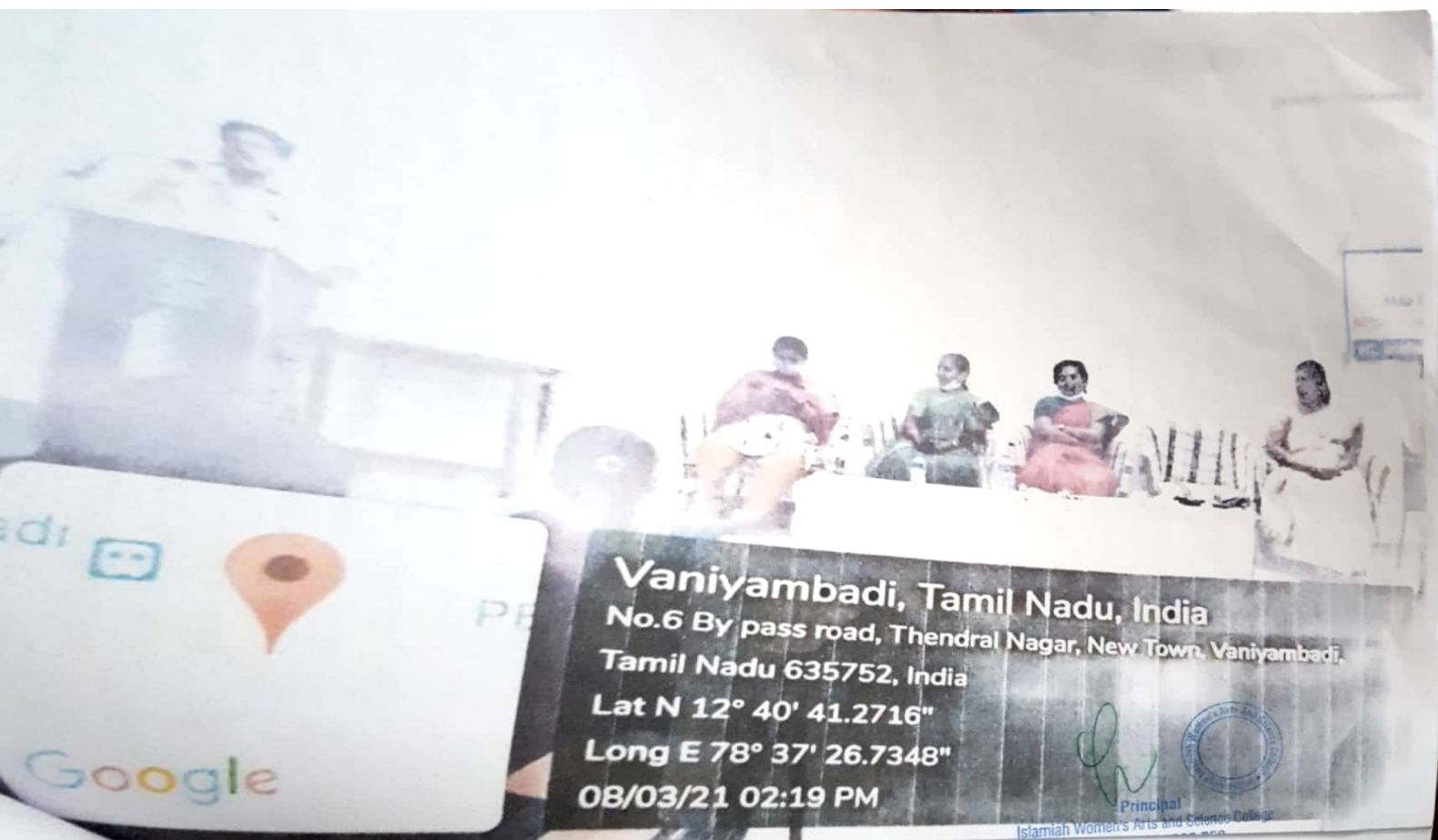

PROTECTING DEMOCRACY - WOMEN'S RIGHT TO VOTE

REPORT

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Islamiah Women's Arts & Science College organized a Women's Day Election awareness program on PROTECTING DEMOCRACY - WOMEN'S RIGHT TO VOTE on 08.03.2021 between 1.00 to 2.30 pm in the seminar hall. Nearly 500 students and staff members participated in the program. Ms. Gayathri Subramani, Returning Officer, 047 Vaniyambadi Assembly Constituency and Revenue Divisional Officer, Vaniyambadi, Mr. M. Mohan M. A., Assistant Returning Officer, Vaniyambadi Assembly Constituency and Tahsildar, Vaniyambadi and Mr. Sudhakar, Election Deputy Tahsildar were the resource persons for the occasion which began with the recitation of verses from the Holy Quran with its English & Tamil translations

Dr. M. Renu, Principal, IWASC alluding to the history behind the origin of 8<sup>th</sup> March as Women's Day in France, spoke about how the concept of Women enjoying equal rights with men was considered preposterous, but which with untiring persistence of generations of women, much of the outdated and oppressive practices that governed our society for over a millennia was discarded for a much more liberating equitable environment.

Ms. Gayathri Subramani initially spoke about the women who worked in the RDO office and how each seems to exemplify some aspect of bravery, courage, cunning, wisdom, kindness, perfectionism, aptitude to multi-task etc., Later she spoke about the need for women's participation in the voting process as it is the one place where they can voice out their opinion on matters that concern them equally.

Mr. M. Mohan M. A. gave an overview of the poll booths available in the region and the women-friendly measures that were taken by their department to make it safe for the women voters.

Mr. Sudhakar using the statistics obtained in the last ten years proved that there is a decline in the number of women voters and the risk the society faces in the nomination of leaders unworthy of the post, not suitable for the job they are chosen for. All the speakers reinforced the need for unequivocal participation in the upcoming elections and upholding the rights conferred upon the citizens of the country by the constitution. 



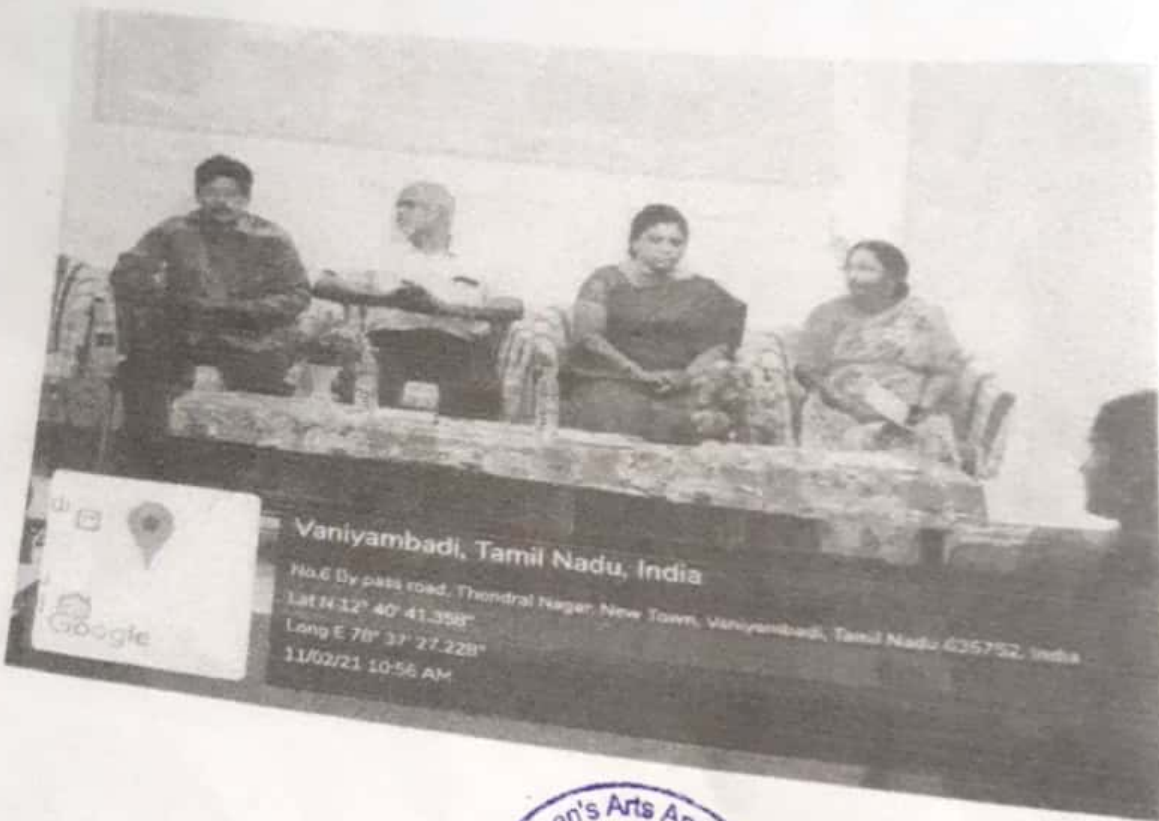


## "WORKSHOP ON MUSHROOM CULTIVATION"
