II. OBJECTIVES OF THE PRACTICE:

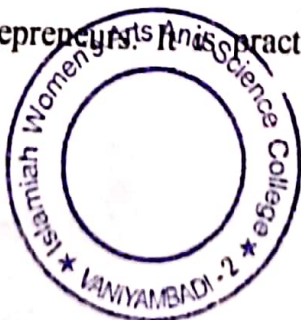
The main objective of the practice is to impart entrepreneurial skills to start business by the students to get self-employed and to provide jobs to others.


II. THE CONTEXT

The women entrepreneur development wing of the DIC (District Industrial Centre) was involved to give training to the women to start business and to inform government subsidies available. Skill Development Centre established by our Management offers the training.

III. THE PRACTICE:

Women Entrepreneurial development is a unique practice to facilitate women to become entrepreneurs. It is practiced by organizing workshops with

The success of the program is evidenced from the fact that many of our women students have started online business on clothes, such as dress materials, stoles, scarves etc. and some of them have opened fancy stores selling hair and body accessories.

IV. PRACTICE:

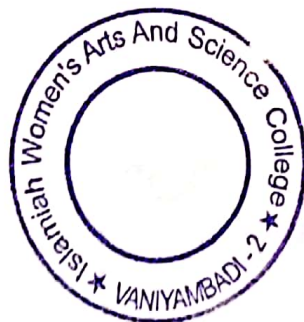
