ANALYSIS REPORT OF STUDENT'S FEEDBACK 2021-2022

- 1. More than 83% students agree that the curriculum is designed to enhance their employability.
- 2. More than 90% of the students have got positive approach towards the idea that the curriculum studied by them is relevant and the contents are revised at reasonable intervals.
- 3. Approximately 91% students have said that the the courses studied by them have enhanced their knowledge as well as their skills and capabilities.
- 4. Nearly 80% students have opined that ICT tools, PowerPoint presentation, web resources, mobile applications, E-content etc., are used by most of the teachers while teaching.
- 5. About 80% students have said that the entire syllabus is completed on time
- 6. Almost 85% of the students have replied that the teachers guide the students for the overall personality development.

- 10. About 82% students have agreed that the continuous Internal Assessment and evaluation process is regular, fair and unbiased.
- 11. Nearly 75% students believe that the teachers give freedom in opting elective course.
- 12. Nearly 90% students have agreed that the the teachers encourage the students to participate in Extra-curricular, Co-curricular activities and certificate courses.
- 13. About 85% students have agreed that the teachers encourage the students to use reference books, E-resources, E-journals etc.,

14. Almost 70% students have said that the teachers keep the students updated about the latest developments in the subject/area of knowledge.

- 15. More than 70% students have agreed that the syllabus include experiential learning through project work/Internship during the program.
- 16. About 80% have said that the teachers impart content beyond the prescribed syllabus.
- 17. Nearly 90% students have agreed that the participative learning part of regular teaching-learning process.
