ANNUAL REPORT 2021-2022

Respected President, Esteemed General Secretary, Revered College Secretary and Honourable Members of the Executive Committee.

Assalamu Alaikum!

I take great pleasure in presenting the Annual Report of Islamiah Women's Arts and Science College, Vaniyambadi from 2021-2022.

The College remained closed for Covid'19 and served as a Quarantine centre from 29.04.21 to 12.08.2021. The Academic year 2021-2022 commenced from 09.08.21 for II & III year students via MS Teams. Regular face-to-face classes on all working days resumed for all the students from 29.11.2021 with SOP.

ADMISSIONS:

The admissions for 2021-2022 closed at 649 students being enrolled in UG and 63 students in PG programs.

ABOUT THE INSTITUTION:

In Islamiah Women's Arts and Science College we have nearly 2120 students, 102 Teaching staff and 20 Non-teaching staff. We have 12 UG programs, 6 PG programs, 3 M. Phil. programs and 2 Ph.D. Programs.

Our primary concern is to provide quality education. I am glad to state that we have secured 100% results in all UG, PG and M. Phil Courses in the April 2021 End Semester Examinations.

UNIVERSITY INSPECTION COMMISSION

The University Inspection Commission visited the college on 24.1.22 and 28.03.2022 to verify the infrastructural and instructional facilities available in the college for the Continuation of affiliation for III B.Sc. Zoology and II BCA (Additional Section) and to start Additional degree Course B.Sc. Artificial Intelligence, B.Sc. Data Science & PhD in Commerce. The Inspection Commission was fully satisfied and recommended the University.
