ANALYSIS REPORT OF ALUMNI FEEDBACK 2022-23

The Alumni Feedback was collected through online from the Alumni and the existing students during March 2023. A well structured Alumni Feedback Form was administered to collect the Feedback from Alumni outgoing batch of UG and PG students. The following are the findings and observations:

Findings and Observation

- Responses were received from alumni of all the Departments.
- 91% of the respondents studied Under Graduate course either Arts or Science.
- 9% of the respondents studied Post Graduate course either M.A/M.Sc./M.Com respectively.
- 76% of the respondents feel proud to have been graduated from IWASC.
- Majority of the alumni (63%) agree that the College organize various kinds of activities for overall development of students.
- A huge majority of the alumni (60%) are willing to contribute towards development of the institution.
- 58% of the alumni accept that the college redress the student's grievances effectively.
- A vast majority of alumni (more than 70%) agree that the institute provide adequate laboratories and equipment for practical classes.
- Most of the alumni (nearly 70%) have gained sufficient technical knowledge at IWASC.
- 68% of the alumni accept that the course obtained from our college have increased their skills and competence.
- Effective teaching and learning methods are adopted by our teachers. More than 36% of the alumni said that teachers use Practical Classes, PPT Presentations, ICT Classes, Labs, Experimental Learning Methods, Field Visit, Industrial Visit etc., are utilized for effective teaching and learning.
- According to huge majority of the alumni (65%), the courses taught were upto date and relevant to present day world.
- Most of the alumni (54%) agree that the teachers use different teaching tools and techniques for teaching and learning.
- Majority of the alumni (66%) feel that they gained enough confident after graduating from our college to face the outside world.
- 69% of the alumni said that they have acquired adequate knowledge and skills their degree program.
