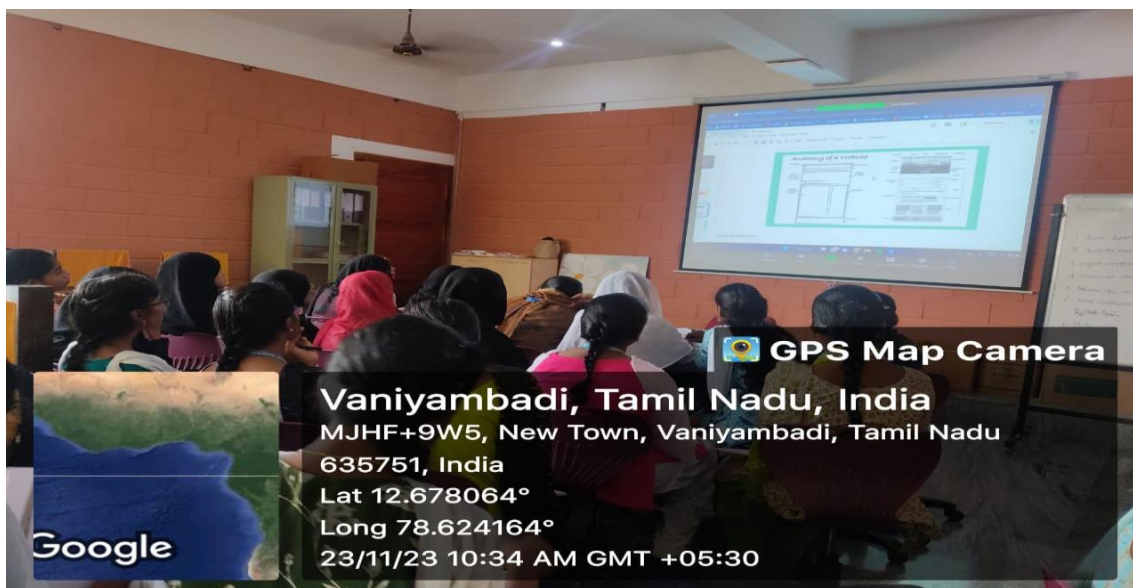
Certificate Course

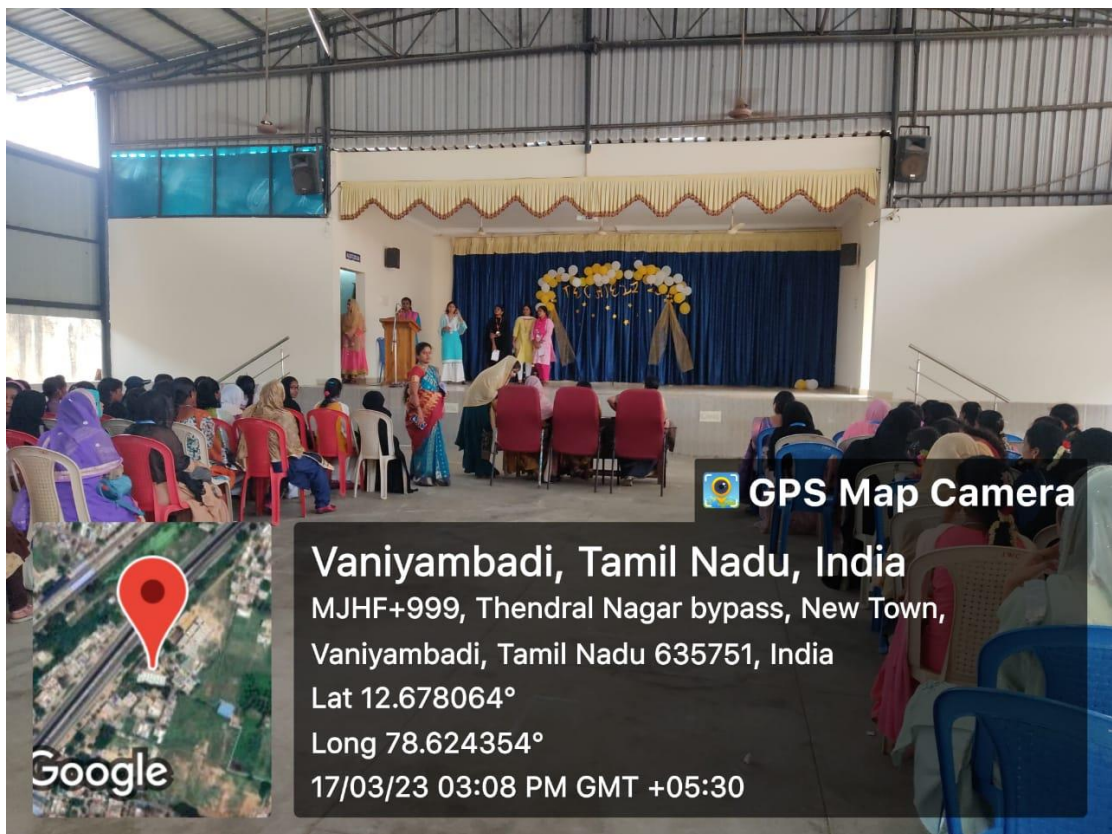
Seminar And Intercollegiate Competition

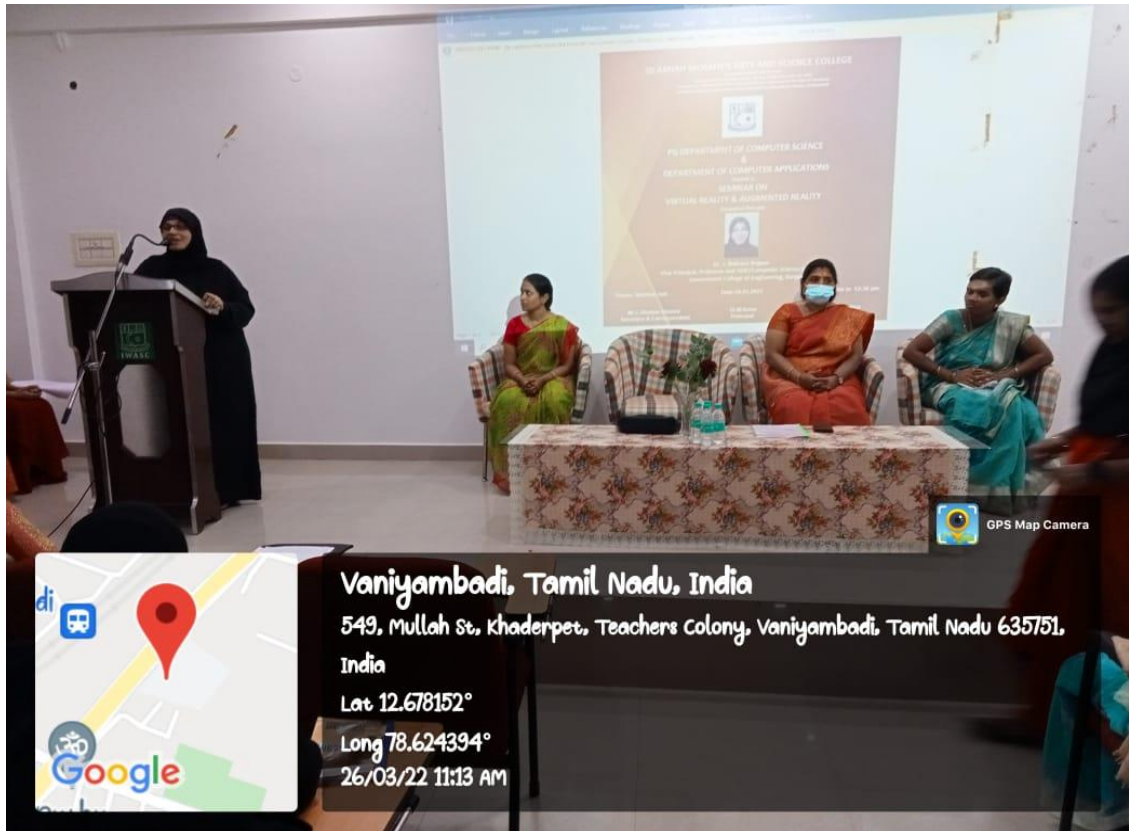

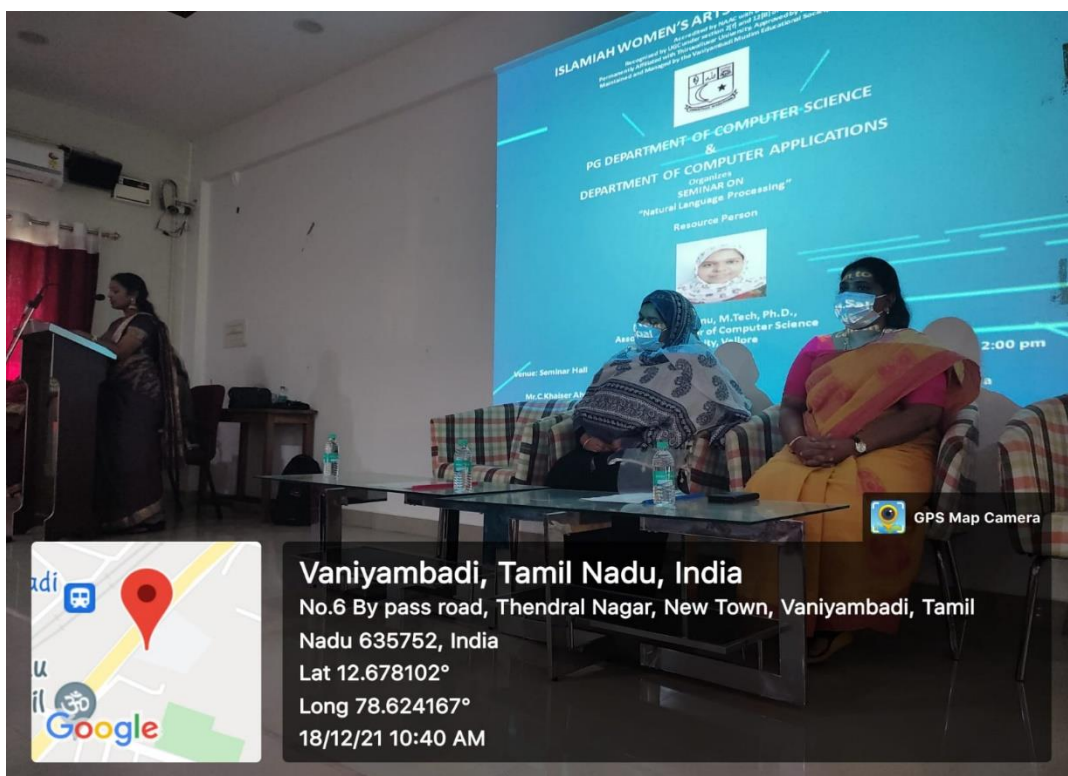
