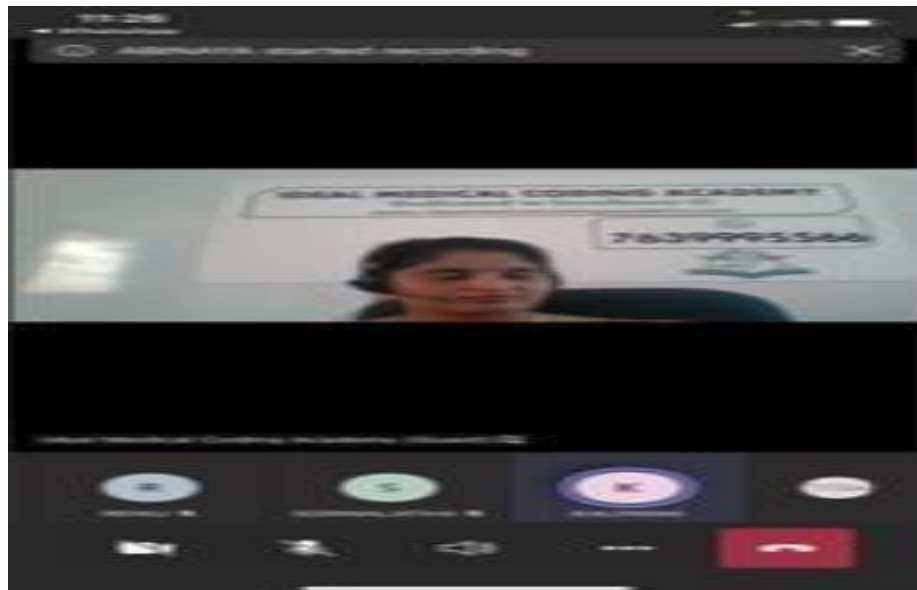

INTERNATIONAL VIRTUAL CONFERENCE

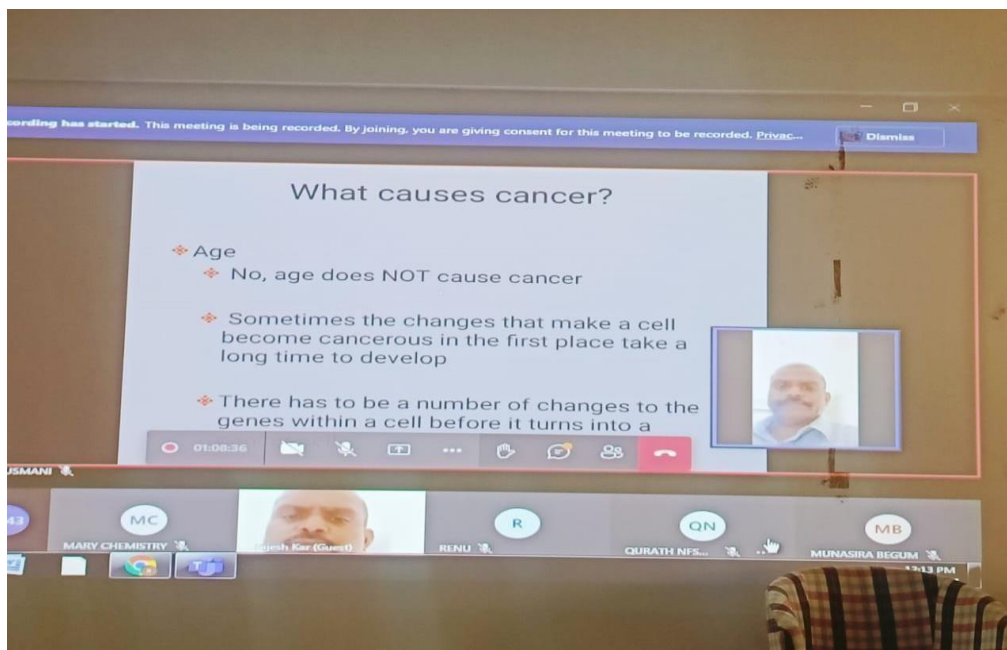
TOPIC OF THE EVENT: Cancer Therapy

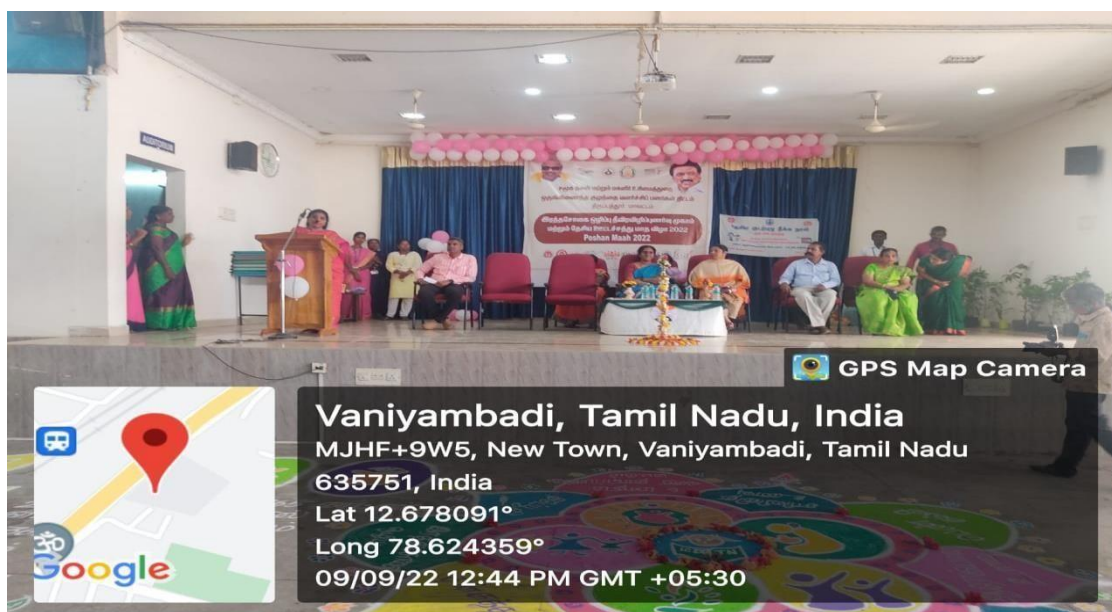
AWARENESS PROGRAM

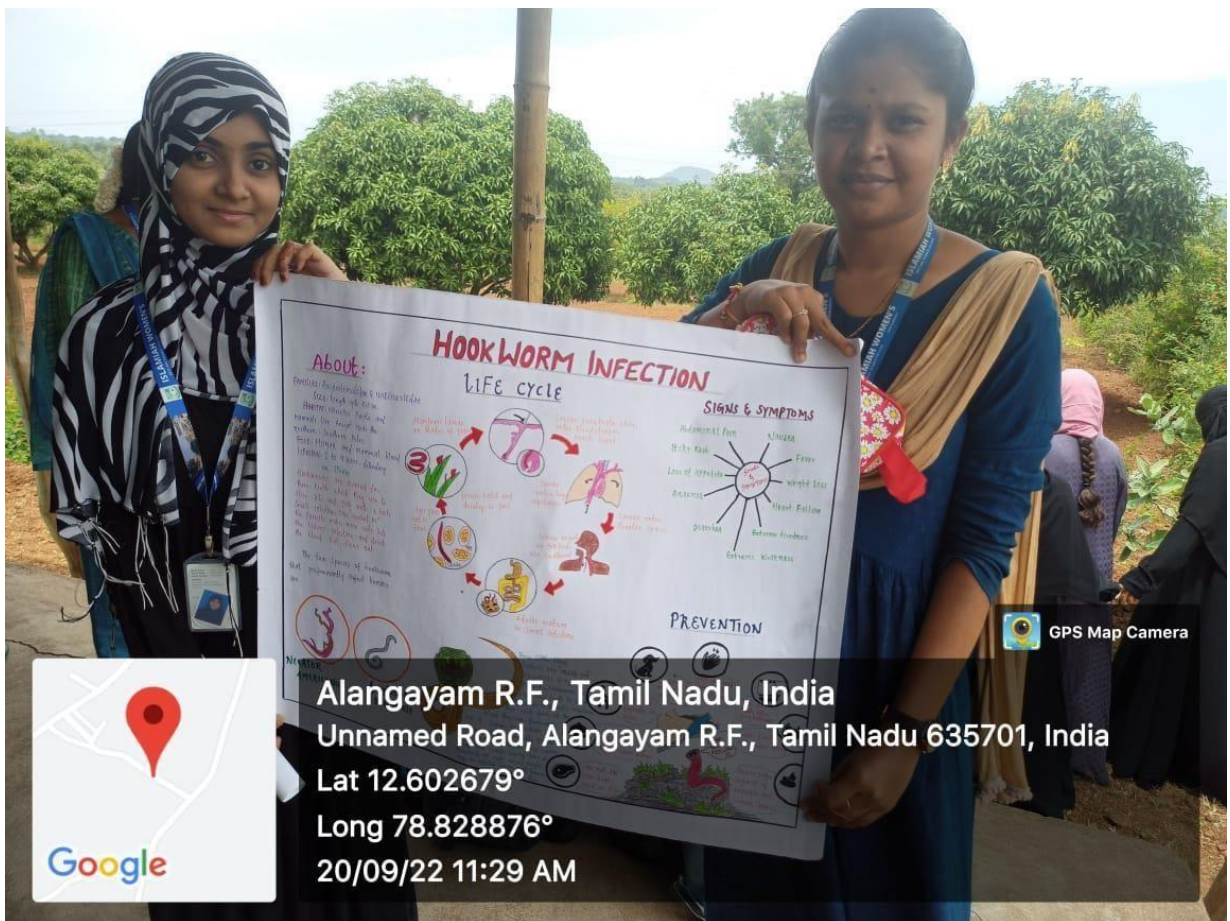


HOOK WORM AWARENESS PROGRAM

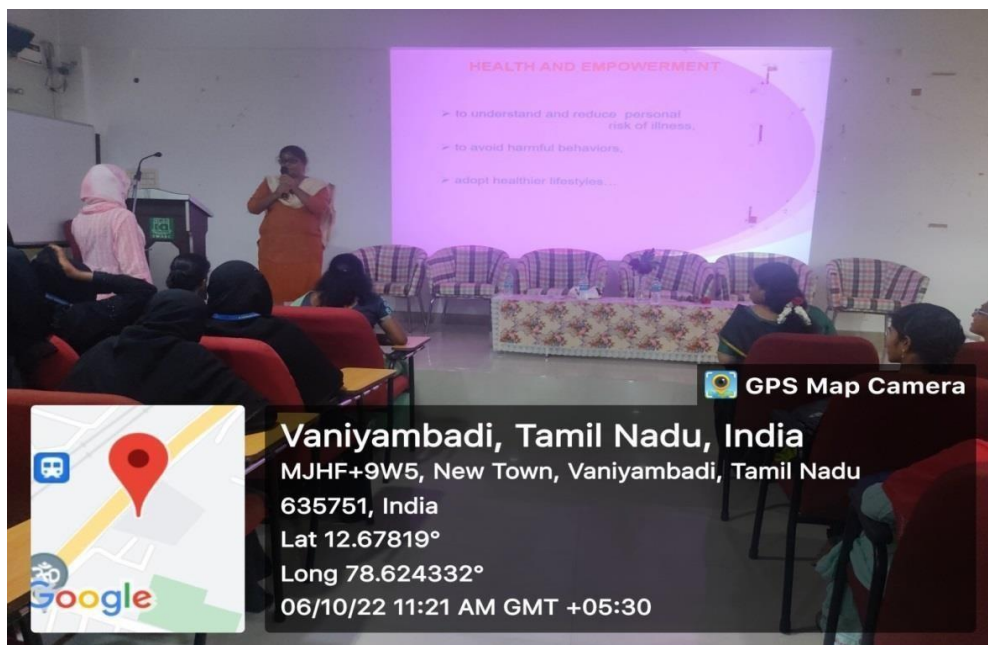
AWARENESS PROGRAM

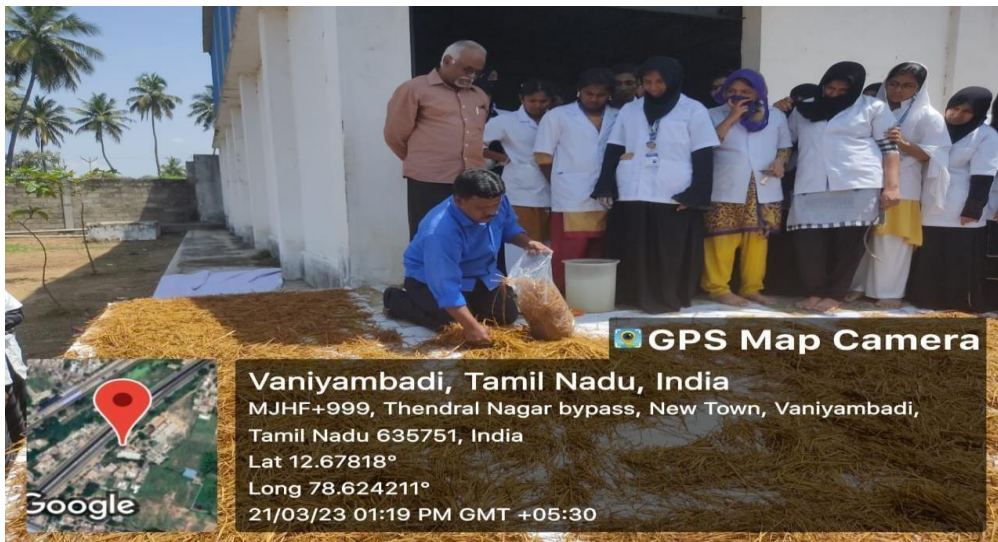
WORKSHOP

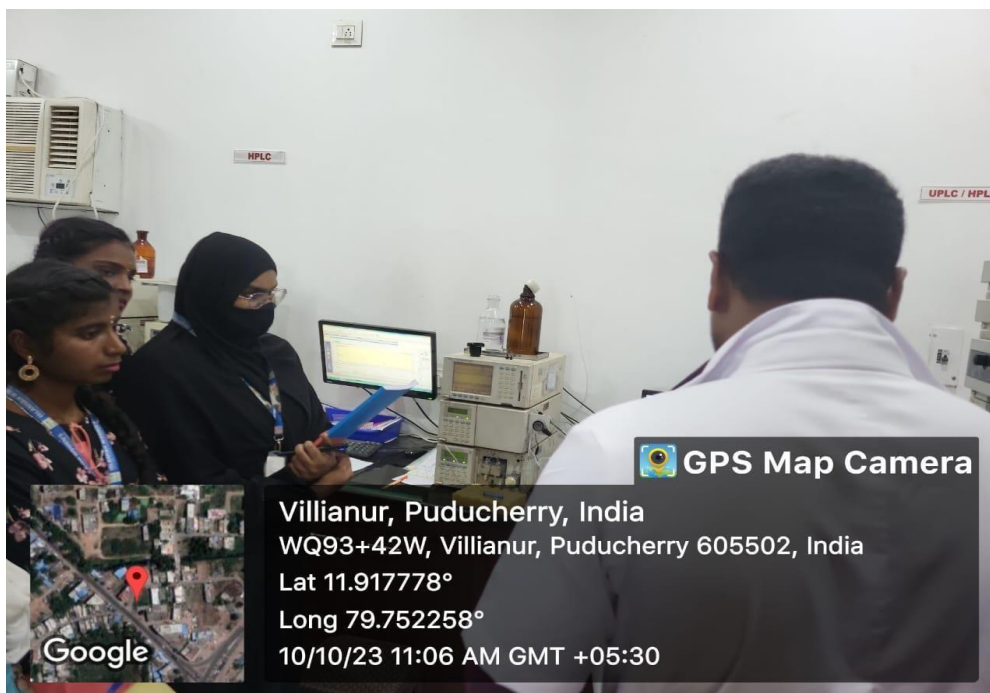

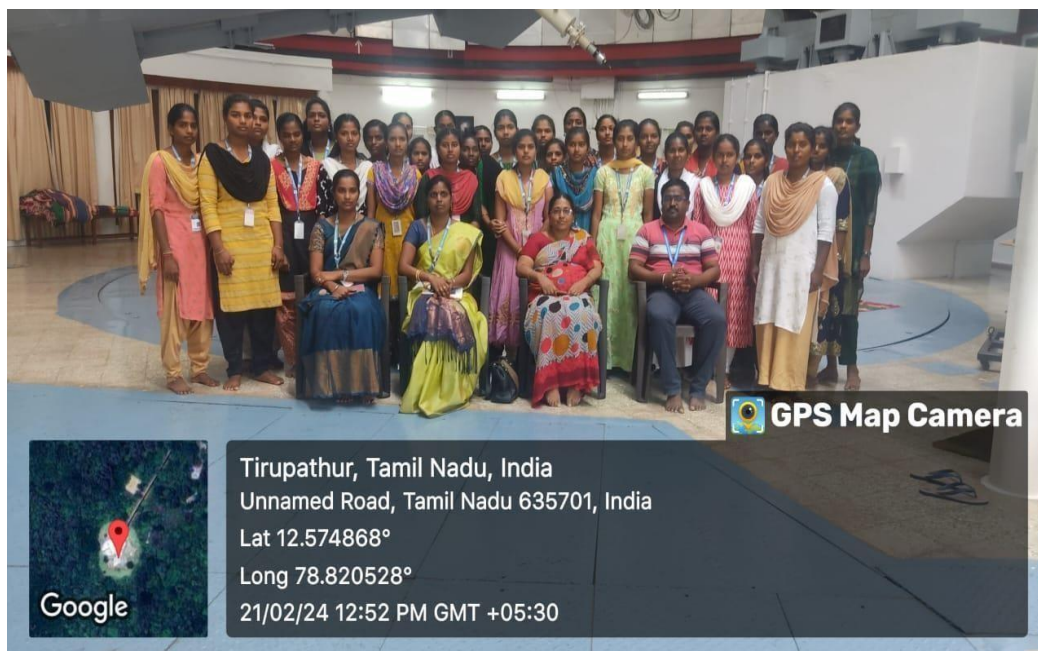
VAINU BAPPU OBSERVATORY VISIT

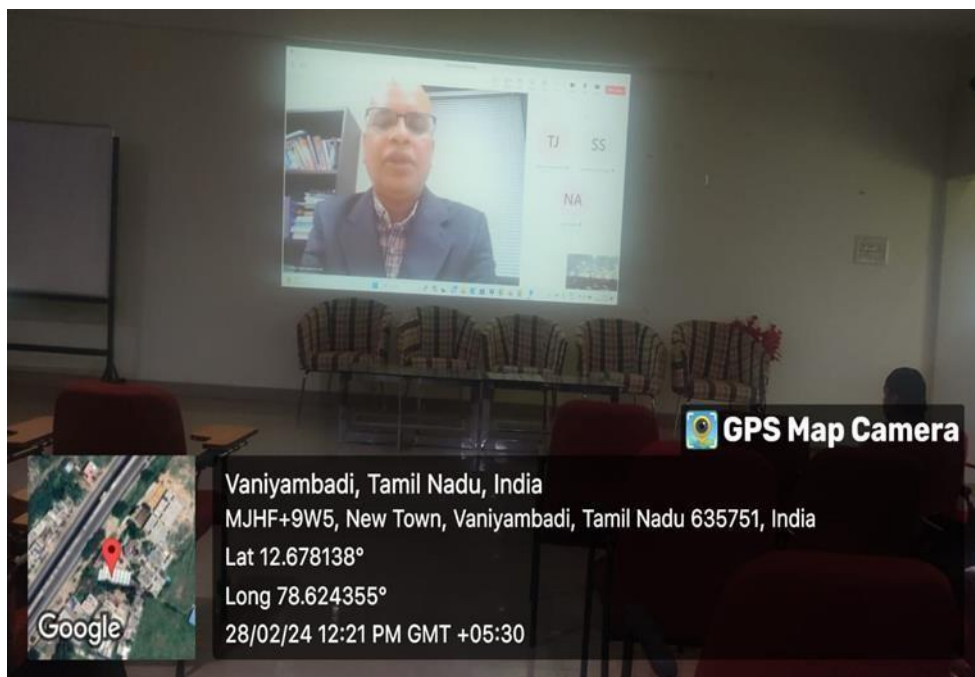
INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR
